A total of around 10 million euros in federal funding is available. The FFG supports your high-quality research program, which must be open thematically but clearly defined. The maximum public funding (federal and state funding) is 45% with up to 0.675 million euros per year. The call is thematically open (bottom-up) Deadline: 22 October 2024

IHI: Draft Topics for next call published four topics are planned for the next two-stage call for proposals from the Innovative Health Initiative (IHI), which is scheduled to open at the end of June. The following topics are under consideration for inclusion in IHI call 8:
